So Karah and the youth have been meeting at 5:30 PM on Sunday afternoon for Sunday school/Bible study. I'm supportive of this idea as I think it will be good for the youth and will likely fit their schedules better. Karah has been having between 8—14 youth on Sundays. They're also meeting on Wednesday evenings at 6:00 PM. Karah is considering ways to encourage the youth to invite their friends, plans for this summer, and ideas regarding Resurrection. She already has the advantage of knowing our youth with strong relationships she has formed with them over the years.
