

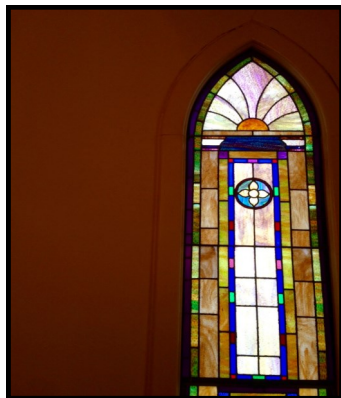
Joining Soddy UMC...

If you are interested in becoming a member of Soddy UMC, we would be honored to welcome you into our fellowship. **Please pick up a copy of our MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION handout or request one from the pastor.** After prayerfully reviewing the membership information and expectations, there are several ways you may join Soddy UMC:

If you are currently a member of another United Methodist Church: we request a Transfer of Membership from your previous church. You are asked to publicly renew your vows to the United Methodist Church.

If you are a member of another denomination: we will request a transfer of membership from your previous church/denomination. In the absence of a letter of transfer, you are asked to publicly make a Confession of Faith. You will be asked to take the vows of membership to the United Methodist Church.

If you have never been a member of a church: you are asked to publicly make a Confession of Faith and take the vows of membership to the United Methodist Church. If you have never been baptized, we will arrange a time for you to have this sacrament performed.

We are a faith community of all ages and from varied backgrounds. The Soddy Daisy Food Bank, located in the church basement, distributes about 150 boxes of food each month to residents of northern Hamilton County.
