

From the Southern kingdom to the Northern kingdom

Within the Holston Conference, clergy refer to the "Northern kingdom" and the "Southern kingdom" when it comes to appointments. It's a play on the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah in the Old Testament. The southern kingdom of Holston Conference is from Knoxville to Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia, while the northern kingdom extends from Knoxville up to Radford, Virginia.

As most of you know, I'm being reappointed in June. I'll take over at two churches, First UMC and West Galax UMC in Galax, Virginia (about 20 minutes southeast of Wytheville). I'm going from the Southern kingdom to the Norther kingdom of Holston. It's the first time the two churches have

been on a circuit together, and the first time I've ever been responsible for two congregations.

The Pastor Parish Relations Committee has already met with your new pastor. He and his wife have their own home in Hixson, so they won't be living in the parsonage. The Trustees and administrative board will be in dialogue about what to do with the parsonage going forward.

Felicia, Rigby, and I will miss you all very much! You've been our family for the past 11 years, and we couldn't have asked for a better one. You took us in after we'd spent five years in a harsh, toxic appointment that had just about taken everything from us. We arrived here broken, angry, hurt by the church, and deeply wounded by the conference. And you welcomed us in, accepted us, loved on us, gave us time and space to heal, and repeatedly demonstrated your grace, generosity, and devotion. Now that the time has come to say goodbye, I know that we're leaving much healthier and happier. You've been a healing balm for our family, and I don't think we can ever repay your kindness, gentleness, hospitality, and love.

This will be my last newsletter for you. It will be passed off to the Communications Team, who will be responsible for deciding how best to continue communicating with the congregation.

My final Sunday will be June 15 (Father's Day). We'll be celebrating the sacrament of the Lord's Supper that day rather than on the usual first Sunday in June. The message will be "I Have Eagerly Desired..." which comes from Luke 22:15—Jesus said, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover meal with you before my suffering begins." As Jesus longed to spend his final hours with his closest friends, I want us to share in holy Communion together one last time. We'll also be doing a Litany of Farewell and Thanksgiving from the United Methodist Church's Book of Worship.

The final two Sundays in June will be covered by Cindy Cunnyngham and Kathy Jones. Your new pastor will hold his first worship service on Sunday, July 6.

My friends, words cannot express my love and gratitude for this congregation. Even though our friendship will continue, and we'll all be reunited on that distant shore in glory one day, it's nevertheless difficult to say goodbye. But I take solace in knowing that God holds every one of us, and our churches, in his hand. He will not lead us where he is not already present and at work. His plans for us are *not* finished.

I'm reminded of the old Michael W. Smith song "Friends Are Friends Forever," released in 1983. It's beautifully appropriate for saying goodbye:

Packing up the dreams God planted / In the fertile soil of you I can't believe the hopes He's granted Means a chapter of your life is through

I pray for you constantly, ¹⁷asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. ¹⁸I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance. ¹⁹I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him. This is the same mighty power ²⁰that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms.
